

6. Mission and Evangelism

Even though the Mission Board of the CHT Synod was formed since 1960, it did not formally function well because of financial problem. For this reason, it has only six evangelists working in Tangram Presbytery area. The presbytery therefore has to tackle this problem from its limited resources to keep the interest of the public in mission and evangelism growing in people's mind.

7. Seminar, Training and Conference

Seminar on various topics have been conducted every year for rural, social and economic development of the people. Sunday School teachers' training has also been conducted every year at presbytery level.

Church Elders' Conference has been also conducted every year at presbytery level to be well informed of the church elders about various needs, issues and problems faced by members of the church and to help them sorting out the solution by themselves.

In the spheres of administrative structure, women wing organisation called Presbyterian Women Fellowship and Youth Department called Presbyterian Youth Fellowship are organised at the local church, district and presbytery levels to help the women and youth to look after their own needs and to learn, to accept responsibilities for all round development of life at presbytery and in the community.

8. The Position of Women in the Presbytery

Even in the post-Christian era, PWF remains subject to approval by the men led church courts such as local, district, presbytery, synod and even Assembly. Slogan of the PWF right from local to Assembly levels is that they should exercise their own freedom to decide things of importance and have their status in the Presbyterian family as much as parents co-exist in the social and domestic life of a family.
