The main aims and objectives of the Tangram Presbytery PWF is to fulfill the Presbytery PWF decision, to carry out synod level PWF's demands as well as to accomplish any assigned task adopted by the Assembly PWF. From administrative points of view Tangram Presbytery PWF is a branch PWF at presbytery level. Tangram Presbytery PWF not only strictly adhered to the Assembly PWF but also does good work in encouraging women in religious, rural, social and economical upliftment as an overall development and liberation of women from the pre-Christian notion of androcentricism.

4. Position of the Fellowship in the Presbytery

During the non-Christian days under the complete domination of men, women were treated for house keeping and childbearing, subordinate to men and have no independence to develop their wisdom and skill. But since the advent of Christianity almost all androcentric notions of captivating women are almost forgotten and are to some extent abandoned. The author is delighted to see steady and wonderful change of the society structure, women's freedom to exercise in religious life, commitment, their wisdom and skill to enhance development at family, village, inter-village and interacting with other ethnic groups at social, educational and ecclesiastical levels. But at the same time, there are many things that need to be reviewed. There is a lot more to improve women status by gradually eliminating the primitive notion of men domination of women that could be seen in the overall practice of the church even today.

At present the PWF of the Tangram Presbytery has two lady evangelists.

These two lady evangelists are paid by the PWF, committed themselves to fulfill in fund drive to meet the needed assessment for the synod PWF. To this commitment
