IMPORTANT DATES AND EVENTS

- 1905 : Welsh Mission work was set up at Haflong, North Cachar Hills. Revival broke out in Meghalaya.
- 1910 : The first local Church in the Cachar Hill Tribes Synod area established at Jatinga, North Cachar Hills.
- 1928 : Evangelistic work was started at Hrangkhoh village Chaptuk. Formation of Ngaiban Tlang Presbytery.
- 1929 : Cachar Hill Tribes Synod was officially constituted.
- 1935 : Evangelist Lalkhochunga of Vaitang began his work at Chaptuk. First Hrangkhoh convert, Suangchungthang of Chaptuk.
- 1942 : The first native Church among the Hrangkhohs, founded at Chaptuk village, North Cachar Hills.
- 1953, January : Revival broke out in Hrangkhoh area at Michikhur Village, N.C. Hills.
- 1957 : Ordination of first Hrangkhoh Church elder, Upa Vantuzem of Chaptuk.
- 1959 : Formation of Tang Bial (District).
- 1960 : First Meeting of Tang - Bial held at Tangpui. Flowering of the Bamboos and famine took place in N.C. Hills.
- 1963 : Evangelistic work was started among the Hrangkhohs of South Cachar at Gharmurra. Creation of Silchar and Lakhimpur Presbytery out of the South Cachar Presbytery.
